

The Gospel Reveled By Jesus Galatians 1:11 - 12

¹¹ For I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel preached by me is not of human origin. ¹² For I did not receive it from a human source and I was not taught it, but it came by a revelation of Jesus Christ.

Galatians 1:11-12 (CSB)

FOCUS: Where you get your information matters. It determines how you view and react to things. The same is true with your beliefs. If you don't get them from the right source, you will be in eternal trouble.

1. I Tell

1. Literally says, "I make know to you ..."

2. I Taught

1. "... the gospel having been preached by me ..."
2. "... not of human origin ..."

3. I Received

1. "... it came by a revelation of Jesus Christ."

4. So What?

1. Because the gospel comes from God, it is the standard by which we measure every idea, philosophy and religion.
2. Everyone is spiritually thirsty and will seek to quench that thirst with something whether it is good or bad.
3. God revels the gospel to each of us.
